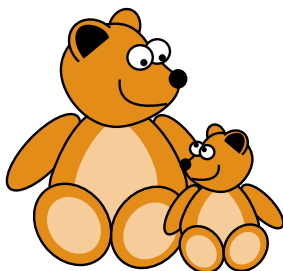

Why is my baby being seen by a Physiotherapist?

This is a routine follow up appointment offered to all babies who have been seen by a Physiotherapist on the Neonatal Unit (Special Care Baby Unit).

What will happen at the appointment?

Your baby will be seen by two Senior Paediatric Physiotherapists. They will ask you questions about your baby's health and routine. The Physiotherapists will then watch your baby to assess how he/she moves and responds to toys. This will give them an idea of your baby's current abilities. The Physiotherapists may also look at your baby's joints and muscles. This will require you to undress your baby to vest and nappy.

Advice

The Physiotherapists will provide you with ideas for positioning your baby and activities to do at home. These will promote your baby's physical development. The Physiotherapist may then arrange to see your baby again in two to three months time.



Appointments

Your baby will be seen in the Child Development Centre in the Horton Wing of St Luke's Hospital.

Please allow half an hour for your visits.

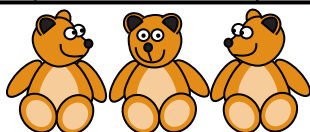
If you are unable to attend your appointment please let us know by telephoning (01274) 365466. Please give us as much notice as possible so we can give your appointment to another baby.

Please be aware, these clinics only run once a month and if you cancel it may be 1 - 2 months before another appointment is available.

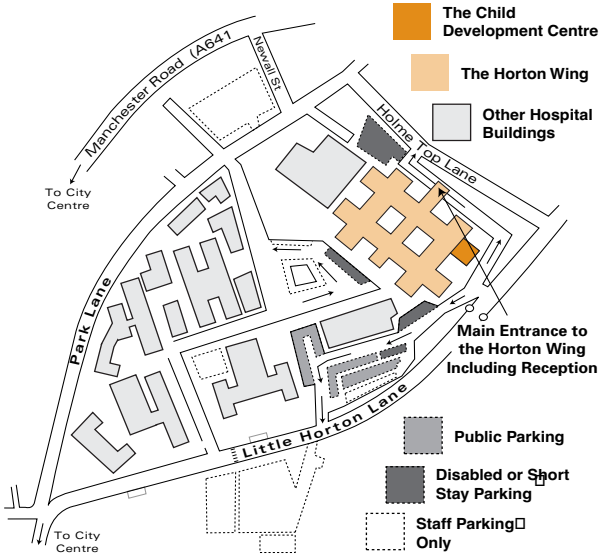
